This meeting will be held under the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Supplementary Regulations

[3] PERMITS

[4] ELIGIBILITY

The event is open to all fully-elected members of Wolverhampton & South Staffs Car Club All entrants must produce a club membership card. Club membership forms will be available at the start for those wishing to join WSSCC at that time

ALL competitors (Driver/Navigator(s)) MUST produce their new RS Clubman license at signing on

[5] CHAMPIONSHIPS

This event is a round of the WSSCC competitors championship

[6] FORMAT

This event is a straight forward, no nonsense fixed route. Wear your slippers, you won't need to get out of the car. There will be a number of locations to visit.

[7] SCHEDULE

[8] ENTRIES

Entries will be accepted in order of receipt. The maximum number of entries will be 12. The entry fee will be £16 Unmodified standard road vehicles and Road Rally specification vehicles that comply with all relevant Road Traffic Act legislation are eligible, but must be no louder than a 92DB limit. NB: Auxiliary lights are not allowed. Up to four competitors may compete in one car, any one of whom may be nominated as the driver. All potential drivers must sign the driver's declaration on the Entry Form. There are no separate classes in this event. All competitors will be considered as one class
