Wolverhampton and South Staffordshire Car Club Ltd will organise a Streetcar all forwards Autotest Championship in 2024. Points will be allocated based firstly on your position relative to other championship entrants and secondly in relation to all competitors in your class.

The championship will consist of up to eight rounds the best five of which will count to establish the overall winner and class positions.

1.1 TITLE and JURISDICTION

2024 WSSCC Ltd AUTOTEST CHAMPIONSHIP. The Championship is organised and administered by WSSCC Ltd in accordance with the General Championship Prescriptions of Motorsport UK and these Regulations.

1.3 COMPETITOR ELIGIBILITY

- 1.3.1 Drivers must be a member of Wolverhampton and South Staffordshire Car Club Ltd and registered in the Championship. As for all Clubman status events a Motorsport UK Competition Licence will be required which can be obtained at no cost from https://rsclubman.motorsportuk.org
- 1.3.2 Points cannot be claimed before registration is made and acknowledged.
- 1.3.3 For points to be scored a 2024 WSSCC Ltd AUTOTEST CHAMPIONSHIP decal must be displayed on the competing car whilst competing.

- 1.4.4 Registration closes 10 min before first car starts round 3.
- 1.4.5 Championship registration does not guarantee an entry to qualifying evens. This is the responsibility of the championship entrant.

1.5 CHAMPIONSHIP CALENDAR

1.5.1 The Championship calendar will consist of a maximum of 8 events. Any changes will be at the discretion of the organising committee, including substitution of an event and will be published on the website and/ or notified to registered competitors.

1.5.2 The minimum number of events that constitute a Championship is 5

2. THE CHAMPIONSHIP

- 2.1 The Championship will be scored on both the entrants position relative to other WSSCC Streetcar Autotest championship entrants overall and their position relative to all event entrants in their class.
- 2.2 The competitor with the highest number of points will be the Overall Winner. The competitor with the highest number of points in each class will be the class winner.
- 2.3 Passengers may be carried, subject to Event Regulations
- 2.4 Points will be awarded as outlined in section 5 below.

3. AWARDS

First Overall: The WSSCC Streetcar Autotest Trophy plus an award.

First in each Class: An Award subject to a minimum of three entrants in that class.

Novice award: A novice driver is defined as never won an award in this discipline at the time of entering the championship.

Additional awards may be presented at the discretion of the Organising Committee.

- 4. CLASSES
- A. Production front wheel drive cars up to 1400cc
- B. Production front wheel drive cars over 1400cc
- C. Modified front wheel drive cars i.e road rally spec/de Cat/ vehicles fitted with a roll cage and Stage Rally cars up to 1000cc
- D. Production rear wheel drive cars
- E. Four wheel drive cars. All cars fitted with a LSD & modified rear wheel drive cars.
- F. Stage rally/ Sprint cars over 1000cc/ unfair advantage
- G. EV any all electric vehicles.

Standard production cars are those running with original panel & window materials. They must have full trim & trim although the type may be replaced. Turbo cars will have an engine capacity multiplier of 1.4 applied.

They must retain the original manufacturer's engine type fitted in the original position. The engine may be tuned and modified.

Suspension may be altered within its original configuration and tyres must comply with Motorsport UK regulations, that is List 1B & 1C tyres, and with the event organisers regulations.

5. SCORING

- 5.1 Points for the Overall Championship will be scored based on the following formula. 20 for 1st overall, 19 for 2nd, etc., down to 1 point for 20th place and lower, between WSSCC Ltd Autotest Championship competitors only. In addition, there will be 10 points for 1st in class, 9 for 2nd, etc. down to 1 point for 10th place and lower, taking all competitors into account and based on the event classes whether they are the same as the championship classes and/or amalgamated.
- 5.2 Starting points will also be awarded to overall Championship scores giving each competitor 5 points for starting an event.
- 5.3 Ties will be decided in favour of the driver with the greatest number of maximum scores in their 8 qualifying scores, then in the event of a further tie, the driver who has gained the greatest number of the next highest scores, and so on. If still unresolved then the competitor who beats the most competitors in their Class on their first counting event will be the winner, and if still equal the second, etc.
- 5.4 Championship standings will be published on the WSSCC website in a timely manner following each round, competitors will have 7 days from publishing of the results after each round for any queries in terms of points awarded.
